- 1. Molded handles near the top and base make it easy to hoist the bag in and out of your car.
- 2. A magnetic ball pocket means no zippering required.
- 3. Individual club compartments make choosing your weapon a cinch.



Ping Latitude

- 1. Treat your flatstick right with a stand-alone putter well.
- 2. Retractable strap adds comfort when toting on one shoulder.
- 3. Features include a towel ring and a Velcro loop to hang a golf glove.



Sun Mountain Zero-G

189 weighs: 5.4 lbs sun



- 1. Use this molded handle to pick up the bag, or push down to extend legs.
- 2. The ball liner is meant for precise, straight marks.
- 3. Triangular footpads provide a stable base when legs are extended.
