X-Tra Traction stand

1. Molded handles near the top and base make it easy to hoist the bag in and out of your car.
2. A magnetic ball pocket means no zippering required.
3. Individual club compartments make choosing your weapon a cinch.



Ping Latitude

Ball pocket = shag bag

1. Treat your flatstick right with a stand-alone putter well.
2. Retractable strap adds comfort when toting on one shoulder.
3. Features include a towel ring and a Velcro loop to hang a golf glove.

Padded hip belt

1. Use this molded handle to pick up the bag, or push down to extend legs.
2. The ball liner is meant for precise, straight marks.
3. Triangular footpads provide a stable base when legs are extended.
